**NOTICE**  
**Annual Parish Assembly 2021**



The Local Government Act 1972 requires that a meeting of the parish shall assemble annually on a day between 1st March and 1st June (both dates inclusive).

Please note that due to the COVID-19 coronavirus pandemic, and in accordance with the guidance issued by the Government regarding restrictions on public assemblies, on 4<sup>th</sup> March 2021 the Parish Council voted that it would not be in the interests of public safety for:

- The Parish Council to fix a date for the 2021 Annual Parish Assembly, or
- The Chairman of the Parish Council to convene the 2021 Annual Parish Assembly, or
- Any Parish Councillors to convene the 2021 Annual Parish Assembly.

The chairman of the Annual Parish Assembly or any six local government electors for the parish can convene the Annual Parish Assembly if they wish. Should they want to do this for the 2021 Annual Parish Assembly, then it is recommended that they first study the Government's guidance regarding restrictions on public assemblies, and the requirements of the Local Government Act 1972 as it applies to Annual Parish Assemblies.
