



Opportunities at the Country Park

– Starting September 2022 –

Toilet Cleaning (Paid Role)

Cleaner required to clean the toilets at the Country Park from September. Duties to include replenishing toilet rolls and soap and ensuring the toilets, basins, cubicles and floors are cleaned.

As the toilet block is currently closed, awaiting refurbishment, there are just two portaloos that need a daily clean, which shouldn't take more than an hour – this may increase to 1.5 hours when the toilet block reopens. All necessary equipment can be provided if required. The toilets are open 363 days a year but pre-arranged holiday cover can be provided.

The role would suit either a local cleaning contractor or someone looking to have a small but regular part time, self-employed job. All quotes will be considered.

Toilet Locking Up – Evenings

We are also looking for someone to close the toilets every evening, around 4pm in the winter months and around 6pm in the summer months.

All that is required is to ensure the toilets are empty (avoiding locking anyone in!), turn the lights off and lock up the toilet block.

Perhaps you visit the park every evening, for a stroll or dog walk and this would suit you?

Bin Emptying

We are looking for people to empty the bins in the park once or twice a week – the bins towards the back of the park need emptying using a wheelbarrow and the sacks placed in the large bin by the entrance.

Bin Emptying and Toilet Locking Up could be paid roles but we would greatly appreciate volunteers in order to keep the costs of maintaining the Country Park to a minimum.
